

Tips for Improving Group Prayer and Intercession Times

Prayer Killers: When prayer request time becomes. . .

- A counseling session: This happens when, in sharing prayer requests, you get way more detailed than what people need.
- A griping session: This happens when someone shares a need and it becomes criticizing and complaining about another person.
- Storytelling: Impersonal - when your request has very little to do with you.
- Self-centered vs. truth-centered: Prayer needs to be primarily praying the will of God and responding to God's message to us.

Time Savers:

- Groups of 2 or 3
- Assign prayer requests

Styles or Modes:

- Anybody about anything with or without request time
- One request at a time: Request, then prayer; request, then prayer
- Scripture praying
- Subject specific: Usually relating to aspects of the lesson
- Personal supplication: Identify one thing from the Scripture lesson
